This temple is sited where many weddings should be occurring but because of the difficulty in accommodating brides and photography few weddings were occurring. The client had a vision to make the area in front of the temple a chosen photo spot for weddings and other special occasions and connecting the temple grounds to the Mission Training Center situated just west of the temple grounds. MGB+A recommended relocating the automobile drop-off to the side of the plaza rather than up against the building to create a continuous plaza connecting the temple to the grounds. The remodeled project includes a new reflecting/fountain (reflecting the shape of the temple), water walls, plaza spaces, updated landscaping and a wonderful connection between the temple and the grounds. MGB+A created 3-D models and photo-realistic simulations to give the client a better impression of the final result and shape the final design.
